



Summer Employment Opportunity – Pool Lifeguard(s) Plast Sich, Grafton ON

Plast Toronto is seeking to hire one or two (1 or 2) **Pool Lifeguards** for its Summer Camps in Grafton, Ontario

Duties: Reporting to the Sich General Manager, the Lifeguard(s) will work in cooperation with Camp Cleaner, Caretakers, Camp Administration and Staff to ensure the safety of all who are using the pool.

Pool Lifeguards are responsible for the following:

- Enforcing the rules and regulations of the pool.
- Advising management of unsafe and unsanitary conditions.
- Performing daily routine chores and maintenance to ensure neat and orderly appearance.
- Assisting and communicating with users in a professional and courteous manner and ensure a positive public relations image.
- Monitoring filtration system and water chemistry, including:
 - daily testing of chemical content of water prior to swim and maintaining log
 - notifying Camp Custodian or Facilities Manager of any needs or deficiencies with regards to filtration system or water chemistry
- Safety and Supervision, including:
 - supervising scheduled daily swim periods
 - in cooperation with Camp Cleaner or Custodian, maintaining cleanliness of pool and pool house (change rooms and restroom facilities)
 - administering swim tests for all minors attending camps throughout the summer
 - ensuring all users of the pool, including cottagers, visitors, campers and camp staff are following all relevant safety protocols
 - clearing the pool of non-camp participants prior to daily camp swimming sessions

Requirements/Qualifications*:

- Previous experience as a lifeguard preferred
- Must have current Standard First Aid with CPR-C Certification, which must be dated no more than 2 years from the certification date
- Must have current NLS Certificate [National Lifeguard Service], which must be dated no more than 2 years from the certification date
- Effective communication skills (written and oral)
- Comfortable dealing with people of all ages
- Attentive to detail, responsible, takes initiative

- Ability to work independently as well as in a team
- Candidates must have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with provincial legislation and regulations

Term: full or part time hours, depending on camp needs; minimum 5 weeks, up to 10 weeks, including weekends

Compensation and benefits: \$19.60/hr; on-site shared accommodation available; meals provided June 28-August 1
